

T&M Associates ProjectWise Configuration Guide

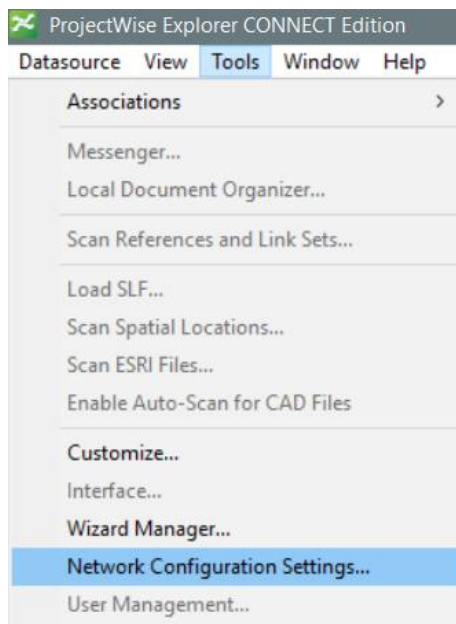
The instructions in this document will help connect to the T&M Associates ProjectWise environment. Please follow these instructions after being notified that you have been invited to a ProjectWise project.

Prerequisites

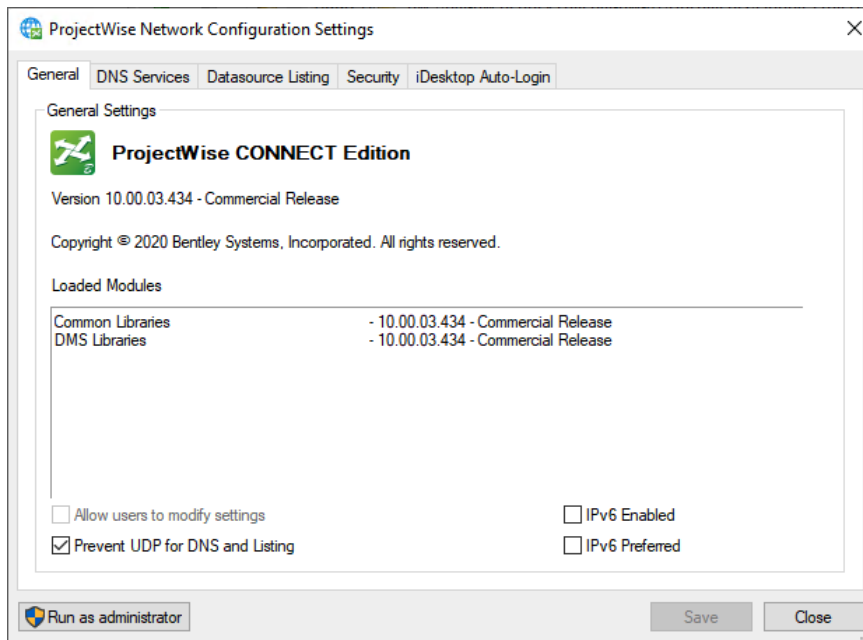
- Ensure **ProjectWise Explorer CONNECT Edition** (ProjectWise Design Integration) is installed on your workstation.
- Ensure you have a Bentley IMS account
 - connect.bentley.com

ProjectWise Explorer Network Configuration

1. Launch ProjectWise Explorer. Click **Tools > Network Configuration Settings**.



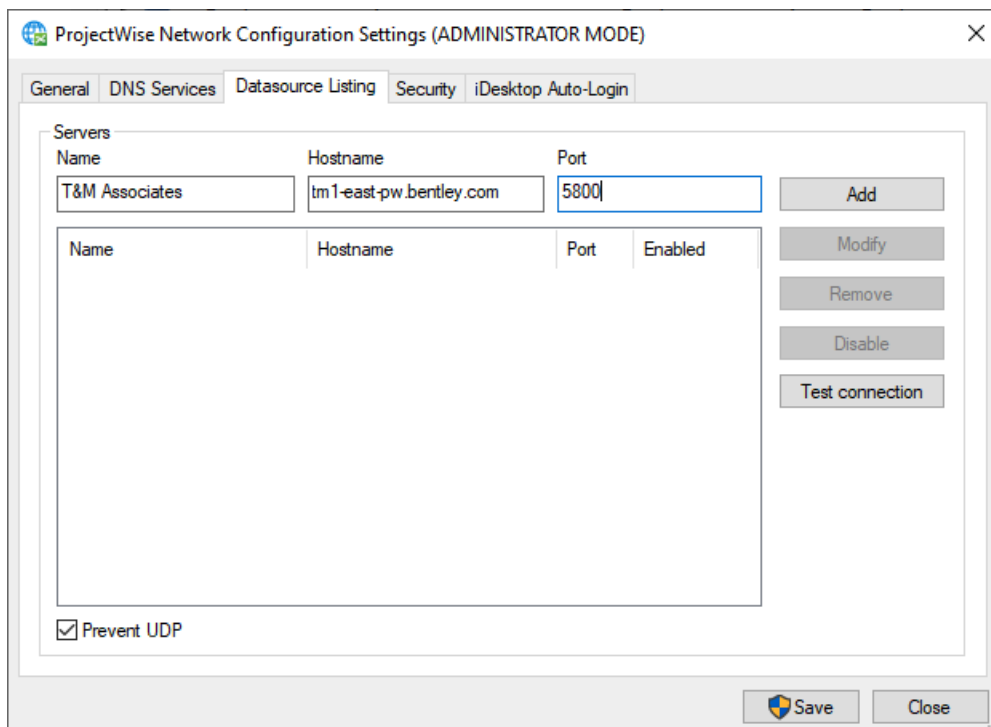
2. On the General tab, click **Run as Administrator** and verify the following settings:



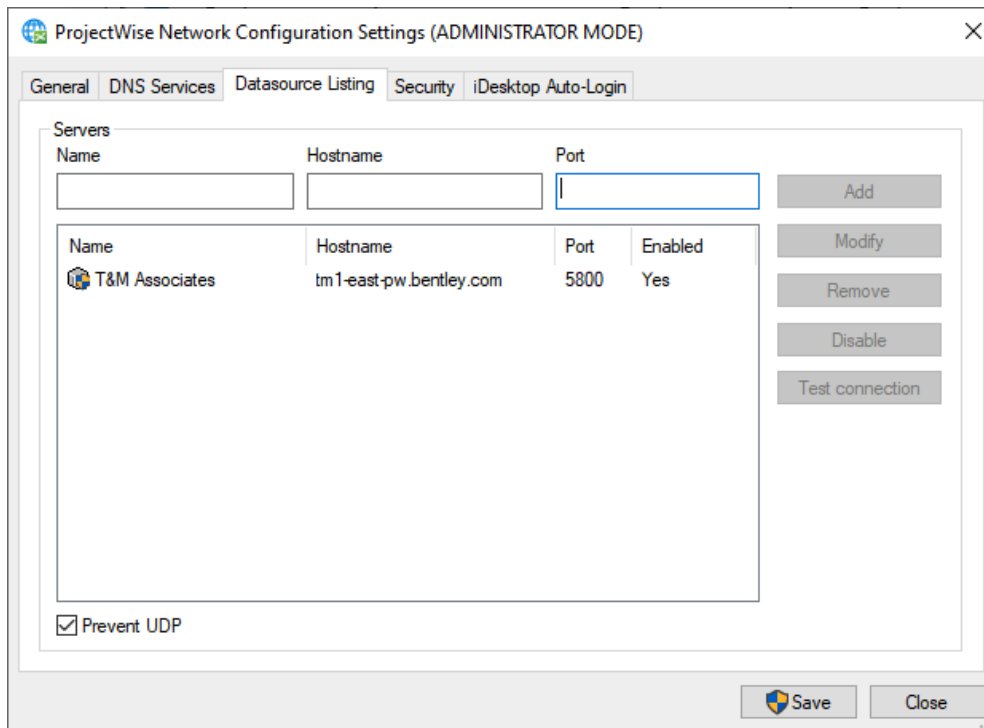
Note, the settings shown on the general tab should include a hard check mark to Prevent UDP for DNS and Listing and the remaining boxes should be empty.

3. Select the **Datasource Listing** tab. Confirm or enter the following information.

- Name: **T&M Associates**
- Hostname: **tm1-east-pw.bentley.com**
- Port: **5800**



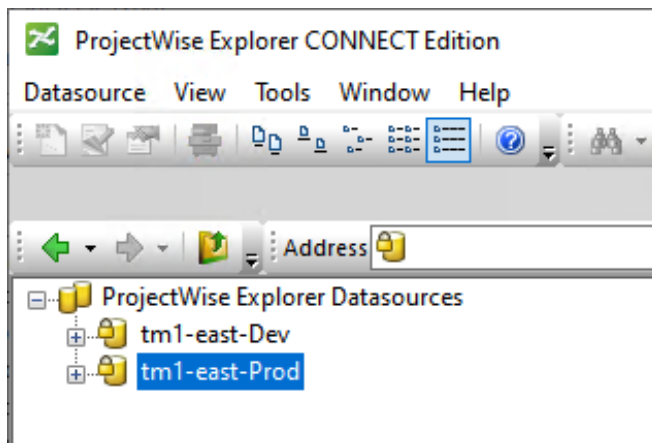
Click **Add**. The entry should now appear in the list:



It is ok to have multiple entries here. Ensure the Prevent UDP checkbox is checked.

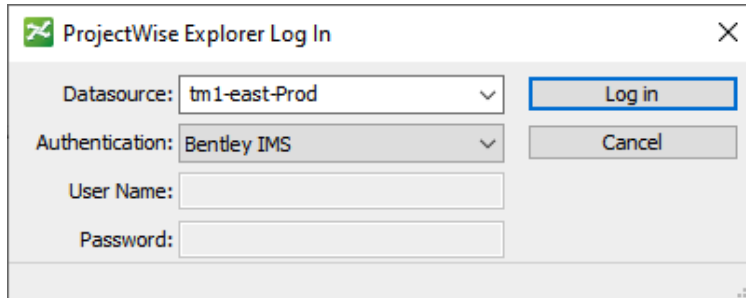
Click **Save** and then **Close**.

4. Refresh ProjectWise or close and re-open. You should now see the **tm1-east-Prod** datasource:

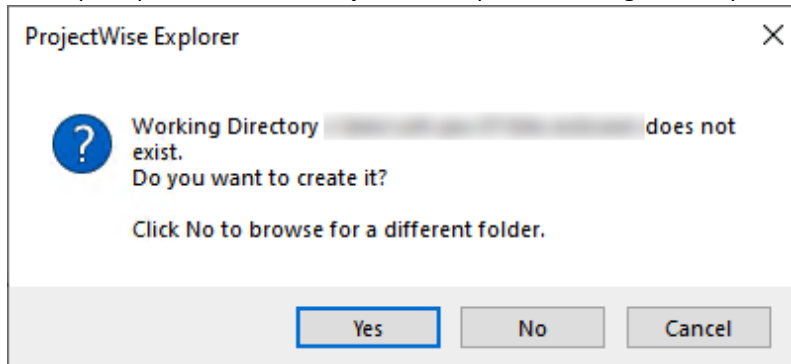


Accessing the tm1-east-Prod Datasource

1. Log into the **Bentley CONNECTION client**.
If you do not have an account, please click New User? Register Now to create.
2. Once you are successfully logged into the **Bentley CONNECTION client**, double click or right mouse click on the **tm1-east-Prod** datasource and choose Log In...
3. If presented with a Log In dialog box, ensure **tm1-east-Prod** is listed as the Datasource name and choose **Bentley IMS** as the Authentication method. Click **Log in**.



4. When prompted to create a ProjectWise Explorer working directory, click **Yes**. This is a one-time action.



5. If an external user account remains inactive for 180 days, it will be disabled. To regain access, the user should contact the Project Manager at T&M Associates.
